## JIRA Agile (formerly GreenHopper)

**Status:**  Compatible

**Limitations:** Version 1.4 of JFS has an ability to restrict user access to JIRA Agile as a whole. JFS does not allow to keep an access to JIRA Agile while securing time-tracking data for certain users.

## Tempo

Tempo plugin has its own security system. JFS should be used along with Tempo to secure JIRA native access to time tracking data, estimations and work logs.
